## Players dominate conditions, create lots of excitement

### OHIO'S HAYDEN TARRIS WINS FIRST TITLE IN FIRST ATTEMPT

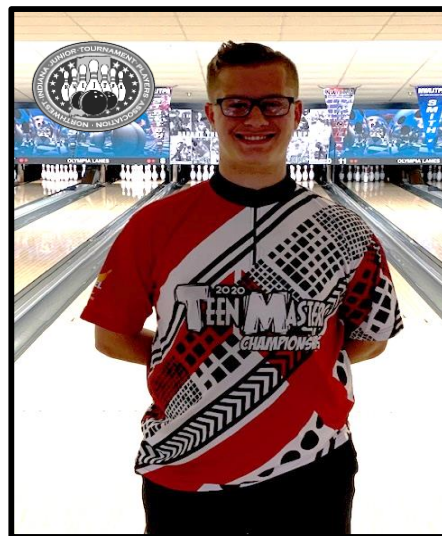
**Defeats Developmental Jr Team USA's Ethan Caruso, Kalamazoo's Anthony Fotis in finale**

Hayden Tarris, Old Fort, OH, qualified 8th after five games, then used an advancers round block of 689 to grab the final championship round spot in fifth place and used that momentum to carry him to the title. Tarris rolled a 437 two-game total in the championship match to out duel #2 seed Ethan Caruso (400) and top seed Anthony Fotis (351) to secure his first NWIJTPA title in his first attempt.

Tarris advanced to the finals with wins over Connor Pula and Joshua Maslanich in earlier rounds.

Top seeded Anthony Fotis (Kalamazoo, MI) electrified the crowd with a 300 during game 3 of qualifying, which followed games of 266 & 265. Fotis was not the only player blistering the lanes as Ethan Caruso averaged 246.2 to lead the initial qualifying segment with Connor Pula right on his tails at 243.6.

Tarris collected \$400 in SMART funds for his win while Caruso (\$300), Fotis (\$225), Maslanich (\$200), and Pula (\$175) increased their SMART balances. Others earning scholarship dollars were Brandon Caruso, David Haffner, Danny LaBonte, Kyle Pranger, Trevor Anifer, and Noblesville's Nathan Smith.

### Krista Gwynn Wins First Main Tour Title

**Anderson, IN star rolls 299 in final game to chase down NWIJTPA Tour Championships Champion Kylee Trexler**

Making her first appearance on the NWIJTPA Main Tour, Anderson IN's Krista Gwynn clearly made her presence known loud and clear. The 15-year old stand-out averaged 231.4 for qualifying, then added 686 during the advancers round to secure the top spot in the championship round, edging Lockport, IL's Isabella Colon. However, in the 3-player title match, Gwynn found herself chasing reigning NWIJTPA Tour Championships Champion Kylee Trexler by 71 pins, a seemingly insurmountable lead with only one game to go. However, Gwynn found her stride and rolled a stunning 299 to edge Trexler 464-454 and claim her first Main Tour title. Brooklinn Chavez claimed third with a 402 total.

Trexler and Chavez earned their places in the title match with wins over Abbie Leiendecker and Isabella Colon in the earlier championship rounds.

Gwynn will add \$400 to her SMART account while Trexler will deposit \$300. Chavez adds \$225, Colon \$175, and Leiendecker \$150. Morgan Brunner will also increase

her SMART balance by \$100. Colon earned the JG spot as well as the High Qualifier award.

### SWEZEY, SALMON WIN ON DTOUR FOR FIRST TIME

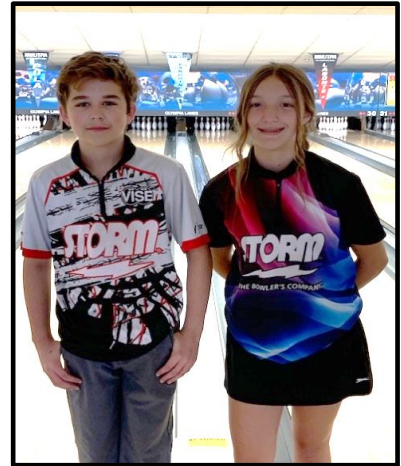
**Ohio's Curtis Swezey outduels Michigan's Cadyn Pranger 254-234**

**In battle of Indiana girls, Highland's Alyssa Salmon downs Demotte's Katrina Laskey 231-190 for title**

The DTOUR seems never to disappoint during the championship rounds and this year's opening Greater Calumet Open was no different. On the girls side, Alyssa Salmon climbed the ladder with wins over Sofia DeLuccia and Anna Holland before dismantling top seeded Katrina Laskey 231-190 in the title match. Salmon, coached by NWI legend John Riffle, earned her first NWIJTPA Dtour title and \$125 in SMART funds.

On the boys side, the action was intense from the get go. Cadyn Pranger needing the first one in the 10th rolled a two-pin for the break of the day to edge Jeremiah Travis 215-201 in the opener. In the semis, Pranger would square off against Richton Park IL's Tyler Williams. Both players would not flinch, each starting with the front 8 bringing the crowd to their feet with each subsequent strike but it was Pranger's streak which ended first leaving an 8 pin in the ninth after Williams struck in his ninth. Pranger calmly stepped up in the tenth and punched for 279 preserving his chance to advance. Williams' 10th looked good off his hands but did not react down lane, leaving the bucket before closing with 276 in the match of the day.

The championship match despite following that electric semi-final did not disappoint. Swezey came out early and let Pranger know he could strike equally as well, and rolled to a 254-234 win for his first Dtour Title and \$125 in SMART funds.

Leiendecker and Crowe then teamed up with the Main Tour Champions in a two game mixed doubles baker match which came down to the last shot. Crowe and Gwynn earned a 410-409 win as Crowe stepped up with three in the tenth to stun the Ohio pair of Leiendecker / Tarris.

In total 19 Main Tour banners were retired. Macailin Rodriguez (9 titles) and Keagan Trexler (6) titles were recognized at the Michiana Cup on Saturday while Cameron Crowe (2 titles), Will Clark (1 title) and Emily Payne (1 title) were awarded Sunday.

Thank you to Olympia Lanes for doing an outstanding job hosting and the Greater Calumet Bowling Association for sponsoring the event. Without partners like this, we would not be able to provide scholarship payouts like we do. For this event, we once again surpassed the 100% scholarship/award payback ratio, awarding \$3875 in scholarships and \$500 in champion and high qualifier prizes compared to standard member entry fees of \$4300.
